Here are a list of questions to get you started:

- 1. What are the procedures for requesting accommodations?
- 2. What documentation is required to request accommodations?
- 3. Are there other students on campus with cochlear implants or hearing loss?
- 4. What types of accommodations are available? What's available for students with cochlear implants?
  - i. Trained tutors or notetakers.
  - ii. Assistive devices such as C-print, Personal FM system, CART, CapTel.
  - iii. Safety devices such as strobes for fire emergency or buddy system.
